

Fernando Mastrangelo's 'Escape' at Maison Gerard, New York

Maison Gerard is set to present "Escape," an exhibition of Fernando Mastrangelo's latest works, on view from April 13, 2017, through May 5, 2017.

Fernando Mastrangelo (b. 1978) uses commonplace materials — salt, coffee, sand, glass and cement — to cast sculptural objects that intricately entangle fine art and design disciplines. Merging commodity materials and pure geometric form, the works are interestingly contradictory. They are also rugged and refined, durable and delicate, formal and functional.

With "Escape," Mastrangelo furthers his signature technique continuing to experiment with, and recast, unexpected materials.
