

# Discoveries by Designers



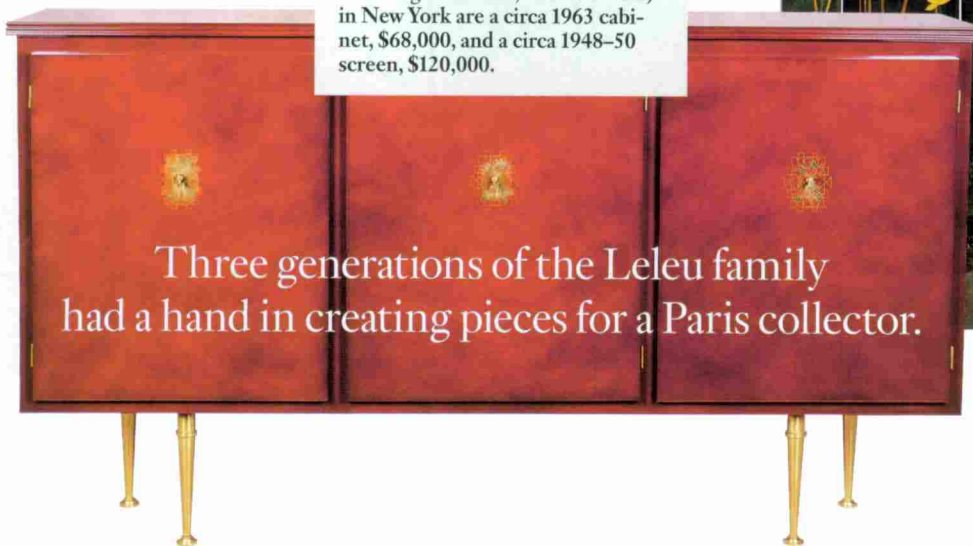
## All White
